- 2 I've been on a lot of antibiotics this year. Can I get CDI?
- 3 I've heard that certain health problems can put people at risk for CDI. Does this include me?
- 4 I've heard people talk about using too many antibiotics. When I get sick, how do I know if I really need an antibiotic?
- 5 If I get diarrhea, how do I know if it is CDI?
